Primary 3 Trip to the Library

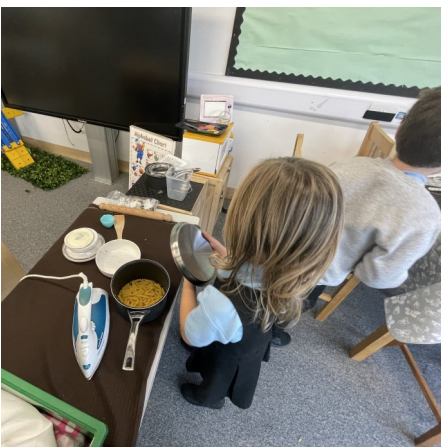
